

Fellesraad Update - Sept 2023 Elaine Helgeson Hasleton, President

It is wonderful that *stevner* were finally in full-force again! There is nothing like in-person gatherings to unite an organization. So, congratulations on all of your diligent work which has paid off!

Haugo Archive & Bibliotek at Norway:

Fellesraad remains busy on many different avenues. Continuous planning and work on sorting books and publications are on-going for the Haugo Archive and *Bibliotek*. The Archive Library Committee is determining which Cataloging software will fit our needs for the Archive.

So far, six *bygdelag* have contributed items from their genealogical collections to the Archive. They are *Gudbrandsdalslag*, *Solørlag*, *Nord Hedmark og Hedemarken*, *Møre og Romsdal*, *Sigdalslag*, and *Sunnhordland*. If a *lag* has duplicate copies of a particular *bygdebok* or publication, then the duplicate is usually placed at Norway House for their use in the Archive. Valuable items are placed in the Haugo Archive with the understanding that the *lag* retains ownership, and these items can be checked out for it's *stevne*.

Bygdebøker are primarily needed, but other helpful publications are accepted, including finding aids, church extracts, census extracts, printed probate records, and periodicals such as history *lag* (*historielagene*) publications. What items does your *lag* have which could be helpful to visitors coming to Norway House? This is your opportunity to shine light on your *lag*, as Archivists/Librarians working in the Archive will highlight specific *lags* for visitors to receive additional assistance.

2025 Emigration Commemoration:

Work has been on-going regarding *Fellesraad* and *bygdelag* participation in this commemoration. One of the founding members of the 1925 Commemoration was Lars Thorkveen, first *Gudbrandsdalslag* President, so *bygdelag* tie-in is close. The 1925 centennial celebration was initiated by *Stavanger Lag*. However, Lars Thorkveen was one of the important planners to ensure that the event occurred. His importance was recognized by a full-page article about him, even though he passed away before the 1925 event occurred. *Fellesraad* is in the midst of planning our participation. We anticipate that both the 2024 as well as the 2025 *Fellesraad* Annual Meetings will have special presentations focused on the 200th Emigration Commemoration.

Other activities:

As **Fellesraad** is the umbrella organization for the *bygdelag*, it is identifying guidelines and procedures for *lag* mergers and also *lag* financial audits. These items will be shared with all *bygdelag* upon completion.

BESTEMOR'S NORWEGIAN MEATBALLS

Mix together in large bowl: 1 1/2 pounds ground beef 1/4 pound pork sausage 2 eggs 1 1/4 cups bread crumbs 1 tablespoon brown sugar 3/4 cup milk 2 teaspoon salt 1/2 teaspoon pepper 1/4 teaspoon ginger 1/2 teaspoon allspice 1/2 teaspoon nutmeg 1/4 teaspoon cardamom 1/2 minced or grated small onion (optional)

Make into small balls and brown in butter or butter and oil in a large skillet. Remove meatballs. Prepare brown gravy in the same skillet (leaving in the meat fat): 2 tablespoons butter 2 tablespoons flour 2 tablespoons cream about 1 1/2 cups beef broth if needed. Add meatballs back and simmer in the gravy until done, about 15 minutes.

Note: Serve with lingonberries, boiled potatoes, and vegetables.
